Activities that can count as a county-wide event include: Fashion Revue, Shepherd's Lead, Specific Judging Contests (FCS, Photography, Crops, Horticulture, Poultry, Livestock), Achievement Banquet, Project Leader Training, County 4-H Club Days, Ski Trip, Exchange Trip, Family Fun Night, Farm Safety Day Camp, Jr. Leader Connection, Recognition Luncheon, 4-H Carnival/Enrollment Fair.
