## MEAT GOATS

Read all rules and requirements completely.

## McPherson County Requirements

- Market goats must attend the county-wide weigh in. All animals will be tagged with an official 4-H EID ear tag. All tags cost \$3.50 each must be paid at weigh-in. Each 4-H family with market livestock (beef, sheep, swine, goat) <u>should</u> complete a Premise ID Registration. Once you get your letter or email, please bring a copy of this form into the office for our records. (You only need to do this once if you completed this process last year you are done).
- A goat identification form must be completed and turned into the Extension Office by May 1 for all *breeding goats*.
  - Animals listed on this form are not transferrable to other 4-H members. By signing this form, you are stating that these are the **only** animals you will be exhibiting.
  - Animals can now be identified by "Families" rather than by individual 4-H members. The definition of a family for the purpose of livestock nominations is "Siblings that share a common parent." You will need to specify who is showing which animal at <u>pre-entry</u> time.
- Animals must be identified as either breeding or market no switching later.
- <u>All goats must have a scrapies tag in the ear or a registered tattoo.</u>

## Out of County/State Requirements

Almost all shows now require some sort of early identification such as: nose prints, ear notching, DNA testing, etc. <u>You will need to decide early if you plan to attend those</u> <u>shows</u>. All forms are available from <u>www.youthlivestock.ksu.edu</u>. All DNA sample envelopes are available from the Extension Office. This year please do not worry about placing an EID sticker on the nomination forms.

## All beef, sheep, swine, and meat goats that plan to attend KJLS and/or Kansas State Fair, must be tagged by the <u>County Extension Agent.</u>

- Only wether goats are allowed to show at KJLS and KSF.
- You must fill out a nomination declaration form, complete the Meat goat nomination form with all contact information and signatures (remember it must have an agent signature), complete a DNA Hair Sample envelope with 40 hair follicles and the \$8 nomination fee with tag number. It must be postmarked by *June 15<sup>th</sup>* to the state.
