Instruction:

Each application must consist of:

- 1. Scholarship Application (this form)
- 2. Copy of updated Permanent Record
- 3. Essay: Minimum of 200 words explaining "what 4-H has meant to me"

Eligibility:

- 1. Must be a graduating senior with plans to pursue a post-secondary education (former graduates are not eligible).
- 2. Must be a currently enrolled 4-H member in McPherson County.
- 3. Must have been an active 4-H member for a minimum of the past 4 years.

Criteria:

The selection committee will be selecting scholarship winners* based on their involvement in 4-H by looking at the following areas:

- 1. 4-H Activities
- 2. 4-H Leadership
- 3. 4-H Citizenship
- 4. 4-H Awards and Honors

*Whether there is one or fifteen applications, only the most qualified 4-H'ers will receive a scholarship. The dollar amount of the scholarship will vary depending on the number of qualified applicants each year.
