McPherson County Requirements

Read all rules and requirements completely.

- A horse identification form must be on file with the extension office by May 1. If you are using the same horse as last year, you must bring in your original ID form for it to be signed and copied. This is a requirement in order for your horse ID to be renewed. There will be no signing of copies within the office as the original has to be signed in order for it to be used at the shows.

- If you have a new horse, or are new to the project, please complete the identification form and return it to the Extension Office by May 1. (Must complete one for every horse you plan to show).
-

- A current negative Coggins test is NOT required for county horse shows, but is for District/State.

- It is recommended that your horses get a West Nile vaccine.

Out of County/State Requirements

- The District horse show will be held in June or July each year in Hutchinson. Watch newsletters and email for dates and information. In order to participate at district, you must:
 - < be 9 (current 4-H age).
 - < pre-enter by the advertised date.
 - < complete Horse Level 1 testing by June 1

- 2 and 3 Year Old Snaffle Bit - The following is due to the State 4-H Office by May 1: completed nomination form, horse ID form, \$10 non-refundable nomination fee, and 4x6 color photo of horse.
